You must be at least 23 years old or older and live within the District 200 school boundaries of Woodstock to be eligible to compete for the scholarships which can be used for tuition, books, or other expenses related to your ongoing education. The initial \$500 scholarship is renewable for an additional \$500 with demonstration of enrollment in an education program that is working towards a degree or certificate and achievement of passing grades.

Please complete and return the accompanying application to the WPBW at the address listed on the form. The application must be received by April 1 to be considered for the available scholarships.

The WPBW organization serves the Woodstock community in a number of ways including participation in the Christmas Clearing House and offers support to women in achieving business and educational goals.
